

Privacy Policy

1. Data controller

1.1. JCI Leuven npo is the data controller for the processing of personal data via this website, in the context of organising the Belgian delegation to the JCI European Conference 2027, including the optional pre-tour.

2. Personal data processed

2.1. In the context of registration and organisation of the event, the following personal data may be processed, among others:

- First and last name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Postal address
- Date of birth
- Nationality
- Room and accommodation preferences
- Billing details
- Information provided via forms or communication

2.2. In certain cases, limited additional data may also be processed where necessary for the organisation, such as dietary preferences or practical needs.

3. Purposes and legal basis of the processing

3.1. Personal data is processed exclusively for the following purposes:

- registration and organisation of participation in the delegation and/or pre-tour
- hotel bookings and room allocations
- logistical organisation (transport, activities, entrance tickets)
- communication with participants
- invoicing and administration
- answering questions and requests

3.2. Processing is based on:

- the necessity for the performance of the contract (article 6.1, b) GDPR);
- the legitimate interest of JCI Leuven npo in organising and communicating about the event (article 6.1, f) GDPR);
- where applicable, the consent of the data subject (article 6.1, a) GDPR).

4. Retention period

4.1. Personal data is not retained longer than legally required and necessary for the purposes for which it is processed.

5. Transfer to third parties

5.1. Personal data may be transferred to third parties insofar as necessary for the organisation of the event, such as:

- hotels
- transport companies
- activity providers
- conference organisers

5.2. These third parties may only use the personal data for the performance of their services.

5.3. In addition, personal data may be shared with processors (such as IT or hosting providers) acting on behalf of JCI Leuven npo.

5.4. Personal data is not transferred outside the European Economic Area, unless subject to the appropriate safeguards provided for in the GDPR.

6. Rights of data subjects

6.1. The data subject has the right to:

- obtain access to his/her personal data;
- have inaccurate data corrected;
- have data erased;
- restrict the processing;
- object to the processing;
- have his/her data transferred (data portability).

6.2. Requests may be addressed to JCI Leuven npo via the contact details mentioned in article 1.

6.3. The data subject also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.

7. Processing of third-party data

7.1. If a participant provides personal data of third parties (for example, roommates), he/she warrants that he/she:

- is entitled to share this data
- has informed the persons concerned about this privacy statement

8. Security

8.1. JCI Leuven npo takes appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss, misuse or destruction.
